

*Nick & Amber*



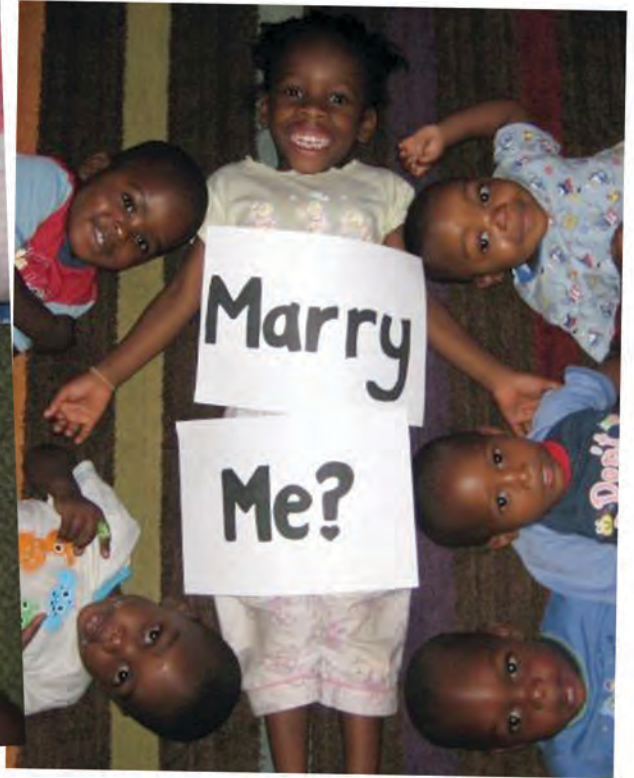

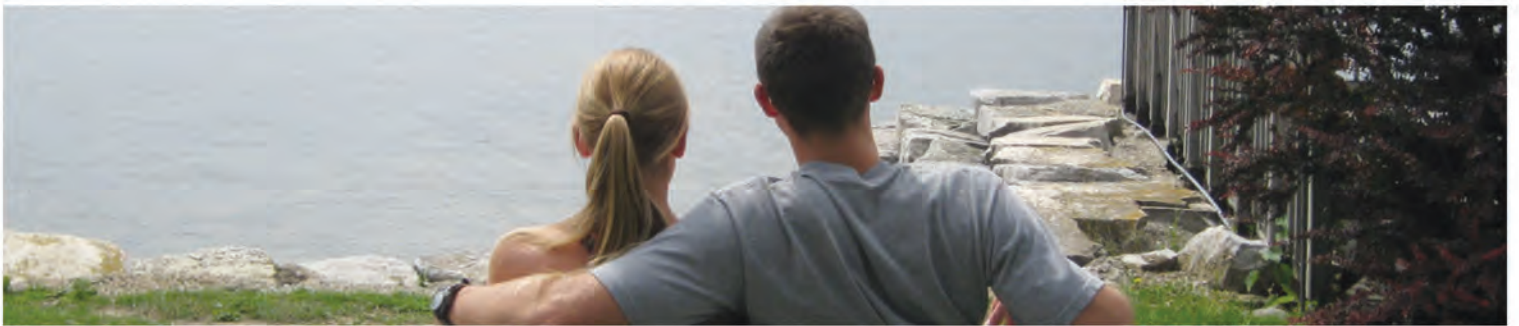
